GUIDELINES:

- UPDATE current pages first—team picture and schedule; follow with pictures; year-end team stats only.
- Eliminate links that cannot be easily updated.
- Share the images you take and use images saved in the public folder K:\Web Page.
- Additional digital images may be available from the Yearbook folder—ask Mrs. Snyders to look for these.
- Do not use last names of students, including your last name in by-line.

Take **great** digital images, edit, and optimize them for use on web pages. Learn how to resize, crop, and brighten images using *Adobe Photoshop*.

- Crop and brighten all images before adding them to the web.
- Complete the "Digital Image Assignment" | take pictures and edit them for use on a NEW student life article.
- You are required to demonstrate your knowledge of our digital equipment and software. This will be taught in small groups and you will take a quiz to measure your understanding.
