- 5 You can only take **one** recreation course in addition to Strength & Conditioning during May Term.
- 6 One period classes last 43 minutes, two period classes last 86 minutes.
- Many classes have limited enrollment, so it is first come, 1st serve.
- 8 Band, Chorus, Spanish I and II will continue during may term.
- 9 If you are in Spanish III, <u>you will continue</u> if you are going on to the next level. All 11th graders must continue in their math class through May Term, except students in Basic Geometry or Consumer/Business Math.

- 11 You MUST take workplace readiness.
